Keepers Cottage is in a rural location near Ledbury in Herefordshire and is home to 8 adults with mild to moderate learning disabilities.

What opportunities are there?

- Everyone contributes to the running of their home. In addition individuals are supported to get involved with their local community for training, education and work experience opportunities.
- Keeping in touch with friends and family is important as well as having an active social life and plenty of leisure activities.



Personalisation:

- Individuals have a Personal Plan and a keyworker to help develop independence skills, maintain a healthy lifestyle and to plan their daily life.
- There are regular meetings to include everyone in decisions about what goes on at Keepers Cottage where views and opinions will be listened to.

- Advocates are routinely involved in life's really big decisions.
- There is a flexible team of well trained staff who can respond as needs change and who work to ensure individuals lead fulfilling lives.
- Keepers Cottage has a vegetable garden and some animals, which provides the opportunity for people who enjoy country living to get involved.

What about the future?

- Everybody living at Keepers Cottage is supported to be involved in meaningful daytime activity which includes opportunities for employment and volunteering in the community.
- Individuals who wish to move on and live more independently are supported to achieve this, to look at housing options, develop appropriate skills and to agree the support they will need.
