We have successfully developed people at Keepers Cottage so that they have been able to move on and live independently in the local community.



Each person will have a Personal Plan which will state how they want to spend their time. A keyworker will help them keep in touch with family and friends, maintain a healthy lifestyle and to involve them in planning their daily life and future.



Keepers Cottage is in a rural location which provides the opportunity for people who have an interest in gardening and animal husbandry to get involved.

Keepers Cottage has a 3 Star CSCI rating. It is one of a number of services run by Salter's Hill Charity which has successfully met the requirements of a number of accreditations which include, Investors in People, Contractors Health & Safety Assessment Scheme, acquA, and the European Quality Standard ISO 9001 as well as the Environmental accreditation 14001:2000.
