



Pound Farm

Pound Farm is in the village of Gorsley on the Gloucestershire/Herefordshire borders.

14 adults with mild to moderate learning disabilities live at Pound Farm which has been divided into 4 flats. There is communal recreational space and gardens. Gorsley is on a bus route, has a local shop/Post Office, a pub as well as two very active Churches.

Everyone who lives at Pound Farm is encouraged to contribute to the running of their flat and daily living skills are an important part of each person's routine.



Attached to Pound Farm is land with a number of animals and a kitchen garden. This provides the opportunity for people who have an interest in land based activities to get involved.

Each person is supported to have a Personal Plan which will agree how they want to spend their time, including accessing community facilities, leisure and work opportunities. Everyone will have a keyworker to help them keep in touch with family and friends,

maintain a healthy lifestyle and to involve them in planning their daily life and future.

One of the flats within Pound Farm is designated as the "Move On" flat – this provides the opportunity for individuals who have the ability and wish to, to move on and live independently in the local community to focus on the specific skills they will need to prepare them for the next stage of their development.

People living at Pound Farm are supported by a flexible team of well trained staff to ensure they lead fulfilling lives, and who can respond as their needs change.



Pound Farm has a 3 Star CSCI rating. It is one of a number of services run by Salter's Hill Charity which has successfully met the requirements of a number of accreditations which include, Investors in People, Contractors Health & Safety Assessment Scheme, acquA, and the European Quality Standard ISO 9001 as well as the Environmental accreditation 14001:2000.
