

Ryelands

Ryelands is a Supported Living accommodation based service which has 5 tenants living in the house and two in a Studio Flat. The service accommodates people who have mild to moderate learning disabilities each of whom is supported to maintain their own tenancies and contribute to running their own home.



Ryelands is in Gorsley near Ross-on-Wye. It has a bus stop just outside the door giving access to local amenities, leisure and work opportunities and nearby towns.

A number of people at Ryelands have paid employment including a local café and a dinner lady and cleaner at a primary school.

Tenants at Ryelands are supported by a flexible team of well trained staff whose aim is to enable them to develop maximum independence.

Each person will be offered a keyworker who will work with them to agree a Plan which addresses their individual needs and wishes.

Keyworkers will also support individuals to enable them to keep in touch with family and friends and encourage them to maintain healthy lifestyles.

The tenants at Ryelands hold regular meetings to ensure everyone is involved in making choices and decisions about how Ryelands is run. Individuals are also supported to attend local Partnership Board meetings and to contribute to Supporting People Provider Forum meetings.



In its most recent Review Ryelands gained a Silver award. It is one of a number of services run by Salter's Hill Charity which has successfully met the requirements of a number of accreditations which include, Investors in People, Contractors Health & Safety Assessment Scheme, acquA, and the European Quality Standard ISO 9001 as well as the Environmental accreditation 14001:2000.
